- DO NOT FLUSH EVERY TIME THERE IS URINE IN THE TOILET
- IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM WITH A TOILET TELL US RIGHT AWAY
- **DO NOT DRINK WATER FROM FAUCET/USE CLEAN WATER FOR BRUSHING TEETH**
- **Drink all water in the bottle and don't leave them setting around. Put your name on bottle.**

At 10PM

- No loud music
- Lights out
- No loud talking
- Don't go in and out of the house banging the screen door

Anyone with any breathing issues must bring adequate meds or machines to aid them. Haiti is very dusty for asthma patients. A missionary recently died due to asthma attack. If someone gets sick here, there is little we can do. Haitian health care is terrible.

Don't hand things out to the people living around us. Always ask first if you see someone you want to give things to.

When you are at the airport do not open your wallet. Or in town, never let others see that you have a lot of money.
